A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE A THREE-FOURTHS MAJORITY VOTE ON ANY INVOLUNTARY "DOWN ZONING" OF PROPERTY. 3 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 160A-385 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 5 "(a1) All cities shall adopt rules providing that no action 'down zoning' or rezoning 6 a property to a less intense use, to which the owner of the subject property does not 7 consent, shall be effective unless three-fourths of all members of the city council vote in 8 9 favor of the action." 10 Sec. 2. G.S. 153A-344 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(c) All counties shall adopt rules providing that no action 'down zoning' or rezoning a property to a less intense use, to which the owner of the subject property does not consent, shall be effective unless three-fourths of all members of the board of county commissioners vote in favor of the action."

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
