Article 1 of Chapter 133 of the General Statutes is amended by 5 adding a new section to read: 6 7 "§ 133-1.2. Names of public works. No city, county, or State work supported wholly or in part with public funds may be 8 named after a living person. G.S. 133-4 does not apply to this section." 9 Sec. 2. Article 8 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by 10 adding a new section to read: 11 "§ 143-135.6. Names of public buildings. 12 No building for the State, or for any county or municipality built pursuant to this 13 Article may be named after a living person." 14 Sec. 3. G.S. 136-18(8) reads as rewritten: 15 To give suitable names to State highways and change the names as 16 determined by the Board of Transportation of any highways that shall 17 18 become a part of the State system of highways. highways: Provided. 19 no State highway may be named after a living person." Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification. 20
