Referred to: Human Resources April 10, 1989 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ELIMINATE MONTHLY REPORTING REQUIREMENTS IN THE FOOD STAMP PROGRAM. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Chapter 108A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 108A-52.1. Redeterminations of eligibility. The Department of Human Resources shall not impose monthly reporting requirements on food stamp recipients as a method of determining a person's continued eligibility for the food stamp program. The Department of Human Resources shall use prospective budgeting in determining a person's continued eligibility for food stamps." Sec. 2. This section shall become effective October 1, 1989, and applies to eligibility determinations made on and after that date.

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
