A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF STATE FUNDS FOR CERTAIN STUDENT  
AND COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. It is the intent of the General Assembly that State funds should not be used, either directly or indirectly, to permit or promote any gay or lesbian association or any other community or campus organization that advocates immoral, illegal, or criminal behavior on any student campus, whether a campus of a constituent institution of The University of North Carolina or of the Department of Community Colleges.

(a) The Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina shall adopt rules to ensure that no State funds and no student fees are used, whether directly or indirectly, to permit or promote any gay or lesbian association or any other community or campus organization that advocates immoral, illegal, or criminal behavior on any of the campuses of the constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina. This prohibition shall extend to the allowed use of any campus building or facility.

(b) The State Board of Community Colleges shall adopt rules to ensure that no State funds and no student fees are used, whether directly or indirectly, to permit or promote any gay or lesbian association or any other community or campus organization that advocates immoral, illegal, or criminal behavior on any of the community college campuses. This prohibition shall extend to the allowed use of any campus building or facility.

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989, and applies to academic years beginning with the 1989-90 fiscal year.
