A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE STATUS OF A MILITARY DEPENDENT ELIGIBLE  
FOR IN-STATE TUITION AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 116-143.3(e) reads as rewritten:

"(e) A person charged less than the out-of-State tuition rate solely by reason of this section shall not, during the period of receiving that benefit, qualify for or be the basis of conferring the benefits of G.S. 116-143.1(g), (h), (i), (j), (k), or (l). A person eligible for the in-State tuition rate pursuant to subsection (c) of this section shall be considered an in-State applicant for the purpose of any admission criterion that accepts qualified in-State applicants before qualified out-of-State applicants."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to admissions for academic years beginning academic year 1989-90.
