AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE ADMISSIONS STATUS OF PERSONS ELIGIBLE
FOR IN-STATE TUITION AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. Article 14 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is amended by
adding a new section to read:
"§ 116-143.4. Admissions status of persons charged in-State tuition.
A person eligible for the in-State tuition rate pursuant to this Article shall be
considered an in-State applicant for the purpose of any admission criterion that accepts
qualified in-State applicants before qualified out-of-State applicants."
Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to admissions for
academic years beginning academic year 1989-90.
