A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO ADOPT  
RULES REGARDING THE ALLOTMENT OF TEACHING AND TEACHING  
ASSISTANT POSITIONS FOR SELF-CONTAINED CLASSES OF  
HANDICAPPED CHILDREN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 115C-301(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Allocation of Positions. – The State Board of Education is  
authorized to adopt rules to allot instructional personnel and teachers, within funds  
appropriated.

◆ The State Board shall adopt rules requiring that teaching and teaching assistant  
positions for all self-contained classes of students who are autistic, multiply  
handicapped, severely or profoundly handicapped, or trainably mentally handicapped  
shall be allotted according to the same allotment ratio established for teaching and  
teaching assistant positions in regular classrooms."

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
