| 9  | (1) the lawful hunting of raccoon or opossum during open season with               |
| 10 | artificial lights designed or commonly used in taking raccoon and                  |
| 11 | opossum at night;  |
| 12 | (2) the necessary shining of lights by landholders on their own lands;             |
| 13 | (3) the shining of lights necessary to normal travel by motor vehicles on          |
| 14 | roads or highways; or  |
| 15 | (4) the use of lights by campers and others who are legitimately in these          |
| 16 | areas for other reasons and who are not attempting to attract or to                |
| 17 | immobilize deer by the use of lights."   |
| 18 | Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.                              |
