A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	AN ACT TO REQUIRE REPORTING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
3	ADMINISTRATION OF PARTICIPATION BY DISADVANTAGED
4	BUSINESSES IN PUBLIC PROCUREMENT CONTRACTS AND TO REQUIRE
5	THE DEPARTMENT TO COLLECT, COMPILE, AND REPORT THE DATA.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. G.S. 143-48 reads as rewritten:
8	"§ 143-48. State policy; cooperation in promoting the use of small, minority,
9	physically handicapped and women contractors; purpose.; required
10	annual reports.
11	(a) It is the policy of this State to encourage and promote the use of small,
12	minority, physically handicapped and women contractors in State purchasing of goods
13	and services. All State agencies, institutions and political subdivisions shall cooperate
14	with the Department of Administration and all other State agencies, institutions and
15	political subdivisions in efforts to encourage the use of small, minority, physically
16	handicapped and women contractors in achieving the purpose of this Article, which is to
17	provide for the effective and economical acquisition, management and disposition of
18	goods and services by and through the Department of Administration.
19	(b) Every governmental entity required by statute to use the services of the
20	Department of Administration in the purchase of goods and services shall report to the
21	Department of Administration annually on what percentage of its contract purchases of
22	goods and services, through term contracts and open-market contracts, were from
23	minority-owned businesses, what percentage from female-owned businesses, and what

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1	percentage from disabled-owned businesses. The same governmental entities shall
2	include in their reports what percentages of the contract bids for such purchases were
3	from such businesses. The Department of Administration shall provide instructions to
4	the reporting entities concerning the manner of reporting and the definitions of the
5	businesses referred to in this act, provided that, for the purposes of this act:
6	(1) A business in one of the categories above means one:
7	<u>a.</u> In which at least fifty-one percent (51%) of the business, or of
8	the stock in the case of a corporation, is owned by one or more
9	persons in the category; and
10	b. Of which the management and daily business operations are
11	controlled by one or more persons in the category who own it;
12	and
13	(2) A female or a disabled person is not a minority, unless the female or
14	disabled person is also a member of one of the minority groups
15	described in G.S. 143-128(c)(2)a through d; and
16	(3) A disabled person means a 'handicapped person' as defined in G.S.
17	<u>168A-3(4).</u>
18	The Department of Administration shall collect and compile the data described in this
19	section and report it annually to the General Assembly."
20	Sec. 2. The Department of Administration shall include in its report to the
21	General Assembly in 1991 any data on participation by businesses described in this
22	section that has been reported to it from governmental entities during previous years but
23	that the Department has never reported to a standing committee of the General
24	Assembly.
25	Sec. 3. The Department shall use any moneys available to it that are
26	necessary to implement this act.
27	Sec. 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
