1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION HONORING THE LIVES AND MEMORIES OF VIRGIL
2 BOYLES, JOB HIATT, SAMUEL HILL, JOHN LEWIS PHILLIP JOYCE, JESSE
3 LOWELL, DANIEL MARION, J. A. STONE, AND J. S. VENABLE, THE
4 FOUNDING FATHERS OF PILOT MOUNTAIN, FOR THE CENTENNIAL OF
5 PILOT MOUNTAIN'S FOUNDING.

6 Whereas, March 9, 1989, is the centennial of the founding of Pilot Mountain
7 in Surry County; and

8 Whereas, the founding fathers, Virgil Boyles, Job Hiatt, Samuel Hill, John
9 Lewis Phillip Joyce, Jesse Lowell, Daniel Marion, J. A. Stone, and J. S. Venable, are
10 worthy of honoring and remembering as the centennial is observed by the present
11 residents of the Town of Pilot Mountain, many of whom are direct descendants of the
12 founding fathers;

13 Now, therefore, be it resolved by the House of Representatives:

14 Section 1. The House of Representatives honors the memory of Virgil
15 Boyles, Job Hiatt, Samuel Hill, John Lewis Phillip Joyce, Jesse Lowell, Daniel Marion,
16 J. A. Stone, and J. S. Venable, the founding fathers of the Town of Pilot Mountain in
17 Surry County for the centennial of the incorporation of the Town, which incorporation
18 occurred on March 9, 1889. The House of Representatives also honors the Town of
19 Pilot Mountain in Surry County on March 9, 1989, the date of its centennial.

20 Sec. 2. A certified copy of this resolution shall be transmitted by the
21 Secretary of State to Wilson Smith, the mayor of the Town of Pilot Mountain, and to the
22 commissioners, Margaret Barnes, Joe Coe, Melvin Lambe, and David Lineback.

23 Sec. 3. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
