G.S. 122C-211(d) reads as rewritten: Any individual who voluntarily seeks admission to any 24-hour facility, other 6 "(d) 7 than one in which medical care is an integral component of the treatment, shall have a medical examination within 30 days before or after admission if it is reasonably 8 expected that he will receive treatment for more than 30 days or shall produce a current, 9 valid physical examination, signed by a physician, completed within 12 months of the 10 current admission. When applicable, this examination may be included in an 11 examination conducted to meet the requirements of G.S. 122C-223 or G.S. 122C-232." 12 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989. 13
