A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR HISTORIC PRESERVATION AT THE
OLD TOWN BEAUFORT HISTORIC SITE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Beaufort Historical Association, Inc., in Carteret County the sum of fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year for preservation at the Old Town Beaufort Historical Site which will include:

- (1) Security systems in the Carteret County Courthouse of 1798 and in the 1778 Leffers' Cottage;
- (2) An engineering study for the 1851 Carteret County Jail;
- (3) Preparation and painting the 1835 Josiah Bell House; and
- (4) Replacing and painting custom-made shutters for the Josiah Bell House.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
