**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A NEW BUILDING FOR THE LA GRANGE RESCUE SQUAD.**

Whereas, volunteer rescue squads provide valuable and needed services to the citizens in their districts; and

Whereas, a central place to train and maintain operations is essential for volunteer rescue squads to continue to provide quality service; and

Whereas, volunteer rescue squads rarely have the time to the raise funds; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the La Grange Rescue Squad, in Lenoir County, the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year for a new building to be used as a training center and headquarters facility.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
