January 25, 1989 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION TO PROVIDE A NORTH CAROLINA FLAG FOR DISPLAY OUTSIDE EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL IN NORTH CAROLINA. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Education the sum of forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year to purchase a North Carolina flag for display outside each public school in North Carolina. Any funds remaining after purchasing a flag for each public school shall be used by the Superintendent of Public Instruction for the purchase of flags for public schools not in existence at the time of the initial purchase of flags. Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
