A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPOINT PERSONS TO VARIOUS BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS  
UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE.

Whereas, G.S. 120-121 authorizes the General Assembly to make certain appointments to public offices upon the recommendation of the President of the Senate; and

Whereas, the President of the Senate has made recommendations; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Bruce D. Michelsen of Durham County is appointed to the Alarm Systems Licensing Board for a term to expire June 30, 1992. This is the categorical appointment for a licensee.

Sec. 2. J. Michael Plemmons of Buncombe County is appointed to the Board of Directors of the Western North Carolina Arboretum for a term to expire June 30, 1994.

Sec. 3. Gary M. Garlow of Lincoln County is appointed to the State Building Commission for a term to expire June 30, 1993. This is the categorical appointment for a Professional Engineer.

Sec. 4. Barry Shearer of Mecklenburg County is appointed to the Child Day Care Commission for a term to expire June 30, 1992. This is the categorical appointment for a nonprofit day care operator. Marilyn Lee of Stanly County is appointed to the Child Day Care Commission for a term to expire June 30, 1992. This is the categorical appointment for a for-profit day care operator.

1           Sec. 5. Patricia Louise Tippet of Macon County is appointed to the State  
2 Board of Cosmetic Art Examiners for a term to expire June 30, 1993.

3           Sec. 6. James P. Cain of Wake County and Daniel L. Brawley of New  
4 Hanover County are appointed to the Administrative Rules Review Commission for  
5 terms expiring June 30, 1992. James B. Mallory, III of Iredell County and George W.  
6 Jackson of Person County are appointed to the Administrative Rules Review  
7 Commission for terms expiring June 30, 1991.

8           Sec. 7. Donald Q. Pate of Wake County is appointed to the Board of Trustees  
9 of the Teachers' and State Employees' Comprehensive Major Medical Plan for a term to  
10 expire June 30, 1992.

11           Sec. 8. Jimmy Lewis Moore of Alexander County is appointed to the North  
12 Carolina Medical Database Commission for a term to expire June 30, 1993. This is the  
13 categorical appointment for a representative of a business with fewer than 200  
14 employees.

15           Sec. 9. Robert Bruce Hoyle of Rutherford County is appointed to the State  
16 Fire Commission for a term to expire June 30, 1993.

17           Sec. 10. Carl E. Worsley, Jr. of Dare County is appointed to the North  
18 Carolina Housing Partnership for a term to begin September 1, 1990, and expire August  
19 31, 1993. This is an at-large categorical appointment. Betty Jean "BJ" Harris of  
20 Durham County is appointed to the North Carolina Housing Partnership for a term to  
21 begin effective immediately and expire August 31, 1990, and for a term to begin  
22 September 1, 1990, and to expire August 31, 1993. This is an at-large categorical  
23 appointment. David J. Meachem of Stanly County is appointed to the North Carolina  
24 Housing Partnership for a term to begin September 1, 1990, and to expire August 31,  
25 1993. This is the categorical appointment for an advocate of low-income housing. John  
26 Vereen of Brunswick County is appointed to the North Carolina Housing Partnership  
27 for a term beginning September 1, 1990, and expiring August 31, 1993. This is the  
28 categorical appointment for a representative of the League of Municipalities. Herschel  
29 Allen Redding of Forsyth County is appointed to the North Carolina Housing  
30 Partnership for a term to begin September 1, 1990, and to expire August 31, 1993. This  
31 is the categorical appointment for a representative of home building industry.

32           Sec. 11. Helen Euliss of Alamance County is appointed to the Teaching  
33 Fellows Commission for a term to expire June 30, 1992. Franz Holscher of Gaston  
34 County is appointed to the Teaching Fellows Commission for a term to expire June 30,  
35 1993. Johnny W. Shepherd of Lenoir County is appointed to the Teaching Fellows  
36 Commission for a term to expire June 30, 1991.

37           Sec. 12. Andrew Benjamin (Ben) Lloyd, Jr. of Orange County is appointed  
38 to the North Carolina Milk Commission for a term to expire June 30, 1994. This is the  
39 categorical appointment for a Grade A milk producer whose primary interest is dairy  
40 farming and who sells his milk to a cooperative plant.

41           Sec. 13. Murphy Thomas (Tom) Wagner of Chatham County is appointed to  
42 the North Carolina Low-Level Radioactive Waste Management Authority for a term to  
43 expire June 30, 1994.

1                   Sec. 14. Unless otherwise specified, all appointments made by this act are for  
2 terms to begin upon ratification.

3                   Sec. 15. This act is effective upon ratification.
