13	(4)	Airports, <u>Airports.</u>
14	(5)	Off-street parking facilities, facilities.
15	(6)	Public transportation systems, systems.
16	(7)	Structural and natural stormwater and drainage systems of all types.
17	<u>(8)</u>	Gas production, storage, transmission, and distribution systems,

GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF NORTH CAROLINA

A county may acquire, lease as lessor or lessee, construct, establish, enlarge, 1 improve, extend, maintain, own, operate, and contract for the operation of public 2 3 enterprises in order to furnish services to the county and its citizens. A county may acquire, construct, establish, enlarge, improve, maintain, own, and operate outside its 4 5 borders any public enterprise. 6 A county may by ordinance or resolution adopt adequate and reasonable rules and regulations to protect and regulate a public enterprise belonging to or operated by it. 7 8 A county may operate the part of a gas system that involves activities related to

9 exploring for natural gas or the purchase or lease of natural gas fields, natural gas

10 reserves, or natural gas supplies in a partnership or a joint venture with a natural gas

11 <u>utility or a private enterprise.</u>"
