A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE EDUCATION STUDY COMMISSION TO STUDY THE
CONCEPT OF REQUIRING PARENTS TO SPEND TIME AT SCHOOL WITH
THEIR CHILDREN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Education Study Commission, which was created in Part V of Chapter 802 of the 1989 Session Laws, shall study the concept of requiring parents to spend time at school with their children. During the course of this study, the Education Study Commission shall consider the legislation proposed in the first edition of Senate Bill 1524 of the 1989 Session.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
