| 9      | may vary on the basis of the acreage, size, and nature of the proposed   |  |  |
| 10     | or permitted operations or modifications. In establishing the fee  |  |  |
| 11     | schedule, the Commission shall consider the administrative and   |  |  |
| 12     | personnel costs incurred by the Department for processing applications   |  |  |
| 13     | for permits and permit renewals and modifications and for related  |  |  |
| 14     | compliance activities and safeguards to prevent unusual fee  |  |  |
| 15     | assessments which would result in serious economic burden on an  |  |  |
