A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT FURTHER CONTINUING THE MENTAL HEALTH STUDY 3 COMMISSION.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. The Mental Health Study Commission, established and structured 6 by 1973 General Assembly Resolution 80; Chapter 806, 1973 Session Laws; Chapter 7 185, 1975 Session Laws; Chapter 184, 1977 Session Laws; Chapter 215, 1979 Session 8 Laws; 1979 General Assembly Resolution 20; Chapter 49, 1981 Session Laws; Chapter 9 268, 1983 Session Laws; Chapter 792, 1985 Session Laws; and Chapter 873, 1987 10 Session Laws; is revived and authorized to continue in existence until July 1, 1991.

11 Sec. 2. The continued Mental Health Study Commission shall have all the 12 powers and duties of the original Study Commission as they are necessary to continue 13 the original study, to assist in the implementation of the original and succeeding Study 14 Commission recommendations and to plan further activity on the subject of the study.

15 Sec. 3. Members and staff of the continued Mental Health Study 16 Commission shall receive compensation and expenses as under the original 17 authorization in the 1973 General Assembly Resolution 80. Expenses of the 18 Commission shall be expended by the Department of Human Resources from Budget 19 Code 14460 subhead 1110.

20 Sec. 4. In addition to other studies authorized by law, the Mental Health 21 Study Commission shall:

5	Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
6	Human Resources for the 1989-90 fiscal year the sum of twenty thousand dollars
7	(\$20,000) for the use of the Commission in the study of insurance coverage for mental
8	illness and chemical dependency.
9	Sec. 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
