A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT BEVERAGE CONTAINER YOKES BE 3 DEGRADABLE.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 5 Section 1. Article 52 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended to add 6 a new section to read:

7 "<u>§ 14-399.2. Prohibition of nondegradable plastic beverage container yokes.</u>

No person may sell, use, or distribute for sale in the State any beverage 8 (a) 9 containers connected to each other by a voke or ring type holding device carrier constructed of plastic that is not capable of decomposing into benign subunits by 10 photodegradation, biodegradation, or chemical degradation within one year upon 11 exposure to the elements. Notice of degradability shall be embossed or otherwise 12 indicated on the holding device. This provision shall not prohibit the sale or distribution 13 14 for sale of container yokes to any person outside the State. Any person who sells, uses, or distributes beverage containers in violation of 15 (b)this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than fifty 16 dollars (\$50.00) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00). In lieu of a fine or any 17 portion thereof, or in addition to a fine, any violation of this section may also be 18
