- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - Section 1. G.S. 105-277.3(c) reads as rewritten:

In addition, property may come within the classification described in 7 "(c) subdivision (a)(1) or (2) (1), (2), or (3) above, if (1) (i) it was appraised at its present use 8 value or was eligible for appraisal at its present use value pursuant to that section 9 subdivision (a)(1), (2), or (3) at the time title to the property passed to the present 10 owner, and (2)-(ii) at the time title to the property passed to the present owner he owned 11 other property classified under the same subdivision $\frac{(a)(1)}{a}$ or (2) above. as the 12 transferred property. Classification pursuant to this subsection shall not affect any 13 liability for deferred taxes under G.S. 105-277.4(c) if such taxes were otherwise due at 14 15 the time title passed to the present owner." Sec. 2. This act is effective for taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 16
