SENATE BILL 680

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE 1990 STATE GAMES OF NORTH CAROLINA.

Whereas, the State Games of North Carolina is a festival of amateur sports for all North Carolinians - regardless of age or skill level - including those who are physically disabled; and

Whereas, the State Games is an activity which promotes fitness, fun and recreation for North Carolina's citizens; and

Whereas, the State Games emphasize participation by as many State residents as possible and serve as a catalyst for drawing persons from across the State together in a common cause; and

Whereas, the State Games promote amateur sports, support the United States Olympic movement, and provide outstanding family fun and entertainment; and

Whereas, a significant portion of the State Games competition will be hosted in a number of local communities throughout the State, making the State Games as convenient as possible to the largest number of North Carolina residents; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to North Carolina Amateur Sports the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the 1990 State Games of North Carolina, provided that North Carolina Amateur Sports raises two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) in non-State funds to match this appropriation.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
