The Division of Motor Vehicles states that the Department of Public Instruction estimates that there will be approximately 30,000 "drop outs" per year that would be under the requirements of this bill.

In order to service this level of "new revocations," the Driver's License Section indicates the need for seven additional positions. Based on our discussions with the Division of Motor Vehicles personnel, it appears that each of the positions requested is justified.
