A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO ASSIST A PERSON IN COMMITTING3 SUICIDE.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 5 Section 1. Article 6 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by 6 adding a new section to read:
- 7 "<u>§ 14-17.2. Assisting another to commit suicide.</u>
- 8 <u>Any person who knowingly assists another person to commit suicide is guilty of a</u>
 9 Class H felony."
- 10 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1991, and applies to offenses 11 committed on or after that date.
