A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA 4-H
3 DEVELOPMENT FUND, AT NORTH CAROLINA STATE UNIVERSITY FOR
4 THE NORTH CAROLINA 4-H PROGRAM.

5 Whereas, the North Carolina 4-H and Youth Development Program currently
6 involves more than 200,000 participants, with the support of 25,000 volunteers; and

7 Whereas, the participation of the North Carolina 4-H and Youth Development
8 Program is representative of the State population; and

9 Whereas, the program is focused on relevant issues and needs such as water
10 quality, waste management, career development, energy conservation, and youth at risk;
11 and

12 Whereas, the current expenditure for curriculum is less than 25¢ per child;

13 Now, therefore,

14 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

15 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
16 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one hundred thousand
17 dollars (\$100,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year for the North Carolina 4-H Development
18 Fund at North Carolina State University for curriculum support for the North Carolina
19 4-H Program.

20 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
