AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON PHYSICAL			
FITNESS AND HEALTH TO SANCTION THE STATE GAMES AND OTHER			
COMPETITIVE ATHLETIC EVENTS FOR WHICH SANCTIONING BY THE			
STATE IS REQUIRED.			
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
Section 1. G.S. 130A-33.40 reads as rewritten:			
"§ 130A-33.40. Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Health – creation;			
powers; duties.			
There is hereby created the Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Health in the			
Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources. The Council shall have			
the following functions and duties:			
(1) To promote interest in the area of physical fitness; to consider the need			
for new State programs in the field of physical fitness; to enlist the			
active support of individual citizens, professional and civic groups,			
amateur and professional athletes, voluntary organizations, State and			
local government agencies, private industry and business, and			
community recreation programs in efforts to improve the physical fitness and thereby the health of the citizens of North Carolina;			
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To examine current programs of physical fitness available to the

people of North Carolina, and to make recommendations to the

Governor for coordination of programs to prevent duplication of such

services; to support programs of physical fitness in the public school

systems; to develop cooperative programs with medical, dental, and

1		other groups; to maintain a liaison with government, private and other
2		agencies concerning physical fitness programs; to stimulate research in
3		the area of physical fitness; to sponsor physical fitness workshops,
4		clinics, conferences, and other related activities pertaining to physical
5		fitness throughout the State;
6	(3)	To serve as an agency for recognizing outstanding developments,
7		contributions, and achievements in physical fitness in North Carolina;

9	<u>(3a)</u>	To serve as the North Carolina sanctioning body for the State Games
10		and for other competitive athletic events for which sanctioning by the
11		State is required; and
12		(4) The Council shall-To make an annual report to the Governor
13		and to the Secretary of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources,
14		including therein suggestions and recommendations for the
15		furtherance of the physical fitness of the people of North Carolina."
