A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A NORTH CAROLINA INTERPRETER
CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM APPLICATION AND ASSESSMENT FEE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 8B of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 8B-10. North Carolina Interpreter Classification System application and assessment fee.

The Division of Services for the Deaf and the Hard of Hearing may charge a fifty dollar (\$50.00) fee for participation in the North Carolina Interpreter Classification System program, when implemented. Ten dollars (\$10.00) of this fee is an application fee and forty dollars (\$40.00) of this fee is an assessment fee. The funds from the collected fees shall be used by the Division to cover the cost incurred for the evaluator's travel, postage, videotapes, printing of forms, certification cards, letters, videotaping equipment, and other related supplies, and other costs directly related to the operation of the program."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
