7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	Section 1. G.S. 7A-650(d) reads as rewritten:
9	"(d) Failure of a parent who is personally served to participate in or comply with
10	subsections (a) through (c) may shall result in a civil proceeding for contempt."
11	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1991.
