A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATING ORDINANCES OF
 THE CITY OF DURHAM.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - Section 1. G.S. 14-4(a) reads as rewritten:
- 6 "§ 14-4. Violation of local ordinances misdemeanor.

7 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), if any person shall violate an ordinance 8 of a county, city, or town, he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not 9 more than fifty dollars (\$50.00), five hundred dollars (\$500.00), or imprisoned for not 10 more than 30 days."

11 Sec. 2. This act applies to the City of Durham only and only to those 12 ordinances of the City of Durham that expressly provide that the maximum fine to be 13 imposed for violation is some amount of money greater than fifty dollars (\$50.00).

14 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective 60 days after ratification and applies to 15 offenses committed on or after that effective date.
