A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY THE REGULATION OF TEMPORARY AND OTHER EMPLOYMENT AGENCIES.

Whereas, employment agencies providing temporary employment services on a no-fee basis, and businesses offering employer fee-paid personnel consulting services or temporary help services, are currently unregulated in North Carolina; and

Whereas, such businesses provide employment services to a substantial number of North Carolina's citizens;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the feasibility of regulating employment agencies that provide temporary employment services, and businesses offering employer fee-paid personnel consulting services or temporary help services. The Legislative Research Commission may report its findings, together with any recommended legislation, to the 1992 Session of the 1991 General Assembly, to the 1993 General Assembly, or to both.

Sec. 2. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
