G.S. 105-187.6(a) reads as rewritten: 6 Full Exemptions. The tax imposed by this Article does not apply when a certificate of title is issued as the result of a transfer of a motor vehicle: To the insurer of the motor vehicle under G.S. 20-109.1 because the 8 (1) 9 vehicle is a salvage vehicle. To either a manufacturer, as defined in G.S. 20-285, or a motor vehicle 10 (2) retailer for the purpose of resale. To the State or a local board of education when the motor vehicle is a 12 (3) school bus and is to be used for public school transportation." 13 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991. 14
