A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AMEND THE METHOD OF SELECTING MEMBERS OF THE  
2 NORTH CAROLINA SHERIFFS' EDUCATION AND TRAINING STANDARDS  
3 COMMISSION APPOINTED BY THE NORTH CAROLINA SHERIFFS'  
4 ASSOCIATION.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. G.S. 17E-3(a) reads as rewritten:

8 "(a) There is hereby established the North Carolina Sheriffs' Education and  
9 Training Standards Commission. The Commission shall be composed of 16 members  
10 as follows:

- 11 (1) Sheriffs. – Eleven sheriffs representing each of the Congressional  
12 districts as established and in effect for calendar year 1991, appointed  
13 by the North Carolina Sheriffs' Association, in such manner as shall be  
14 prescribed by the Constitution or bylaws of such Association.  
15 (2) Appointees of the General Assembly. – One person appointed by the  
16 Speaker of the House of Representatives pursuant to Article 16, G.S.  
17 120-121, and one person appointed by the Lieutenant Governor  
18 pursuant to Article 16, G.S. 120-121.  
19 (3) County Commissioners. – One county commissioner appointed by the  
20 Governor as recommended from three nominees from the North  
21 Carolina Association of County Commissioners.  
22 (4) Others. – The President of the Department of Community Colleges or  
23 his designee and the Director of the Institute of Government or his  
24 designee shall be ex officio, nonvoting members of the Commission."

1           Sec. 2. G.S. 17E-3(b) reads as rewritten:

2           "(b) Terms. – Sheriffs representing Congressional Districts 1, 4, 7, and 10 as  
3 established and in effect for calendar year 1991, shall be appointed to a term of one  
4 year; sheriffs representing Congressional Districts 2, 5, 8, and 11 as established and in  
5 effect for calendar year 1991, shall be appointed to a term of two years; sheriffs  
6 representing Congressional Districts 3, 6, and 9 as established and in effect for calendar  
7 year 1991, shall be appointed to a term of three years. The appointee of the House of  
8 Representatives shall serve a term of two years. The appointee of the Senate shall serve  
9 a term of two years. The county commissioner appointed by the North Carolina  
10 Association of County Commissioners shall serve a term of two years. After the initial  
11 terms established herein have expired, all sheriffs appointed to the Commission shall be  
12 appointed to terms of three years.

13           If an individual ceases to be a sheriff then his seat on the Commission becomes  
14 vacated upon his ceasing to be qualified to hold that seat. Any individual appointed or  
15 designated to serve on this Commission shall serve until his successor is appointed and  
16 qualified."

17           Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification and expires September 1, 1993.
