1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO CREATE THE EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES RESEARCH
3	LABORATORY AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THAT PURPOSE.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. There is created the Educational Facilities Research Laboratory.
6	The Laboratory shall be a component of the Applied Research Center of the University
7	of North Carolina at Charlotte. The purposes of the Laboratory are:
8	(1) To examine facility planning issues confronting local boards of
9	education in the State;
10	(2) To address design and technical issues that relate to school facilities;
11	and
12	(3) To disseminate information to local boards of education and public
13	school administrators.
14	The Laboratory may conduct research that includes case studies and
15	experimentation on school facilities relating to such areas as facility effectiveness,
16	construction systems and materials, acoustics, lighting, thermal efficiency and energy
17	conservation, visual perception-room ergonometics, alternative designs, and furniture
18	design.
19	Sec. 2. There is created the Educational Facilities Research Laboratory
20	Board of Advisors. The Board shall consist of nine members, four shall be appointed
21	by the Superintendent of Public Instruction and the remaining five, including the
22	chairman, shall be appointed by the Chancellor of the University. The Board shall
23	advise the Laboratory on general matters that deal with public school facilities.
