G.S. 47-8 reads as rewritten: 5 6 "§ 47.8. Attorney in action not to probate papers therein. No practicing attorney-at-law has power to administer any oaths to a person to any 7 paper-writing to be used in any legal proceedings in which he appears as attorney. However, no court shall enter any ruling affecting the finality of a judgment, otherwise 9 proper, entered in an action or proceeding in which the complaint or any other 10 documents were verified in violation of this section." Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification. 12
