A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT REGARDING DESIGNATION OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS
PRODUCERS' AGENCIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF FEDERAL COMMODITY
ASSESSMENT PROGRAMS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. Article 50 of Chapter 106 of the General Statutes is amended by
adding the following new section:
"§ 106-555.1. Official State board for federal assessment programs; no subsequent
<u>referenda required.</u>
For the purpose of any federal commodity assessment program, the producers'
agency certified by the Board of Agriculture pursuant to G.S. 106-555 shall be deemed
to be the official State board for such commodity. No subsequent referenda shall be
required under this Article in order for such producers' agency to maintain its status as
the official State board for the purposes of such federal commodity assessment
program."
Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
