SENATE BILL 616

Short Title: Pender Criminal Fine Increase.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE FINE FOR A VIOLATION OF AN ORDINANCE OF
PENDER COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 14-4(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Except as provided in subsection (b), if any person shall violate an ordinance of a county, city, or town, he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~, two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00), or imprisoned for not more than 30 days."

Sec. 2. This act applies to Pender County only.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective 60 days after ratification and applies to offenses occurring on or after that date.
