1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR MANDATORY CERTIFICATION OF CLINICAL
3	SOCIAL WORKERS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 90B-3 reads as rewritten:
6	"§ 90B-3. Definitions.
7	(a) <u>'Board' means the</u> (1) Board. – The North Carolina Certification Board for
8	Social Work.
9	(2) <u>Certified Clinical Social Worker. – A person who is competent to function</u>
10	independently, who holds himself or herself out to the public as a social worker, and
11	who offers or provides clinical social work services or supervises others engaging in
12	clinical social work practice.
13	(3) Certified Master Social Worker. – A person who is certified under this
14	Chapter to practice social work as a master social worker and is engaged in the practice
15	<u>of social work.</u>
16	(4) Certified Social Work Manager. – A person who is certified under this
17	Chapter to practice social work as a social work manager and is engaged in the practice
18	<u>of social work.</u>
19	(5) <u>Certified Social Worker. – A person who is certified under this Chapter to</u>
20	practice social work as a social worker and is engaged in the practice of social work.
21	(6) <u>Clinical Social Work Practice. – The professional application of social work</u>
22	theory and methods to the psychosocial diagnosis, treatment, or prevention, of

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emotional and mental disorders. Practice includes the treatment of individuals, couples, 1 2 families, and groups and referrals to and collaboration with other health professionals 3 when appropriate. Clinical social work practice shall not include the provision of supportive daily living services to persons with severe and persistent mental illness as 4 5 defined in G.S. 122C-3(33a). 6 (7)Public practice of social work. – To perform or offer to perform services for 7 other people that involve the application of social work values, principles, and 8 techniques in areas such as social work services, consultation and administration, and 9 social work planning and research. Social Worker. - A (b) 'Social worker' is a person engaging in the public 10 (8)practice of social work who is not certified under this Chapter as a Certified Social 11 12 Worker, Certified Master Social Worker, Certified Clinical Social Worker-Worker, or 13 Certified Social Work Manager, as defined in this Chapter.-Manager. 14 (c) A person is engaged in the 'public practice of social work' who holds himself 15 or herself out to the public as a social worker and who offers to perform or does perform 16 for other persons, services which involve the application of social work values, 17 principles and techniques in areas such as social work services, consultation and 18 administration, and social work planning and research. 19 (d) 'Certified Social Worker,' 'Certified Master Social Worker,' 'Certified Social 20 Work Manager' means a person who is engaged in the practice of social work and who 21 is certified under subparagraphs (b), (c), (d) and (e), respectively, of G.S. 90B-7." Sec. 2. G.S. 90B-4 reads as rewritten: 22 23 "§ 90B-4. Prohibitions. 24 After January 1, 1984, except Except as otherwise provided in this Chapter, it is (a) unlawful for any person who is not certified as a social worker, master social worker, or 25 social work manager under this Chapter, Chapter to represent himself or herself to be 26 27 certified under this Chapter or hold himself or herself out to the public by any title or description denoting that he or she is certified under this Chapter. 28 29 After January 1, 1992, except as otherwise provided in this Chapter, it is (b)30 unlawful to engage in or offer to engage in the practice of clinical social work without first being certified under this Chapter as a clinical social worker. 31 32 Nothing herein shall prohibit school social workers who are certified by the (c)State Board of Education from practicing school social work under the title 'Certified 33 School Social Worker.' Except as provided for certified clinical social workers, Nothing 34 35 nothing herein shall be construed as prohibiting social workers who are not certified by the North Carolina Certification-Board for Social Work-from practicing social work. 36 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, Except as provided herein for certified clinical 37 38 social workers, no agency, institution, board, commission, bureau, department, division, 39 council, member of the Council of State, or officer of the legislative, executive or judicial branches of State government or counties, cities, towns, villages, other 40 municipal corporations, political subdivisions of the State, public authorities, private 41 42 corporations created by act of the General Assembly or any firm or corporation receiving State funds shall require the obtaining or holding of any certificate issued 43

under this Chapter or the taking of an examination held pursuant to this Chapter as a 1 2 requirement for obtaining or continuing in employment." 3 Sec. 3. G.S. 90B-5 reads as rewritten: "§ 90B-5. North Carolina Certification Board for Social Work; appointments; 4 5 terms; composition. 6 (a) For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this Chapter, there is hereby 7 created the North Carolina Certification Board for Social Work which shall consist of 8 seven members appointed by the Governor in the manner hereinafter prescribed. The Governor may remove any member of the Board for neglect of duty or malfeasance or 9 conviction of a felony or other crime of moral turpitude, but for no other reason. as follows: 10 At least two members of the Board shall be Certified Social Workers 11 (1) 12 except that initial appointees shall be persons who meet the educational and experience requirements for certification as Certified 13 Social Workers under the provisions of this Chapter; Workers or 14 Certified Master Social Workers; two-three members shall be Certified 15 Clinical Social Workers except that initial appointees shall be persons 16 who meet the educational and experience requirements for certification 17 as Certified Clinical Social Workers under the provisions of this 18 19 Chapter; and three two members shall be appointed from the public at 20 large. Composition of the Board as to the race and sex of its members shall reflect the composition of the population of the State of North 21 22 Carolina 23 At all times the Board shall include at least one member primarily (2)24 engaged in social work education, at least one member primarily 25 engaged in social work in the public sector, and at least one member primarily engaged in social work in the private sector. 26 All members of the Board shall be residents of the State of North 27 (3) Carolina, and after the establishment of the initial Board, all members,-with 28 29 the exception of the public members, shall be certified by the Board under the provisions of this Chapter. Professional members of the 30 31 Board must be actively engaged in the practice of social work or in the education and training of students in social work, and have been for at 32 least three years prior to their appointment to the Board. Such activity 33 34 during the two years preceding the appointment shall have occurred primarily in this State. 35 36 The Governor may only remove a member of the Board for neglect of duty, (b)malfeasance, or conviction of a felony or other crime of moral turpitude. 37 The term of office of each member of the Board shall be three years; 38 (4)39 provided, however, that of the members first appointed, three shall be appointed for terms of one year, two for terms of two years, and two 40 for terms of three years. No member shall serve more than two 41 42 consecutive three-year terms. (c) (5) The term of office of each member of the Board shall be three years. No 43 member shall serve more than two consecutive three-year terms. Each term of service 44

6	of experience in an administrative setting with appropriate supervision
7	and training; and
8	(3) Has passed the Board examination for the certification of persons in
9	this classification.
10	(f) The Board may issue a provisional certificate in clinical social work to a
11	person who has a master's or doctor's degree in a social work program from a college or
12	university having a social work program approved by the Council on Social Work
13	Education and desires to be certified as a Clinical Social Worker. The provisional
14	certificate may not be issued for a period exceeding two years and the person issued the
15	provisional certificate must practice under the supervision of a certified Clinical Social
16	Worker Board-approved alternate."

18	"§ 90B-10. Exemption from academic qualifications. certain requirements.
19	(a) Applicants who were engaged in the practice of social work before January 1,
20	1984, shall be exempt from the academic qualifications required by this act for Certified
21	Social Workers and Certified Social Work Managers and shall be certified upon passing
22	the Board examination and meeting the experience requirements, if any, for certification
23	of persons in that classification.
24	(b) The following may engage in clinical social work practice without meeting
25	the requirements of G.S. 90B-7(d):
26	(1) <u>A person who has engaged in clinical social work practice for one year</u>
27	prior to the effective date of this act and who properly applies for and
28	pays the required fees for a certificate as a certified clinical social
29	worker prior to January 1, 1994;
30	(2) A student completing a clinical requirement for graduation while
31	pursuing a course of study in social work in an institution accredited
32	by or in candidacy status with the Council on Social Work Education;
33	(3) An employee engaged in clinical social work practice exclusively for
34	one of the following employers:

40	Sec. 6. Chapter 90B of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
41	section to read:
42	"§ 90B-14. Third-party reimbursements.
43	Nothing in this Chapter shall be construed to authorize or require direct third-party
44	reimbursement to persons certified under this Chapter."

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1	Sec. 7. Any proposed substantive changes to G.S. 90B-3, 90B-4, 90B-5,
2	90B-7, or 90B-10 shall be reviewed by the Legislative Committee on New Licensing
3	Boards pursuant to G.S. 120-149.3(e).
4	Sec. 8. This act becomes effective January 1, 1993. G.S. 90B-10(b)(3)a. is
5	repealed effective January 1, 1998. The term of the additional Board position for

6 Clinical Social Worker created by this act shall commence upon the expiration of the

7 term of the public member whose term expires first.
