A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO CREATE THE PESTICIDE ENVIRONMENTAL TRUST FUND, TO BE FUNDED BY AN ASSESSMENT FOR EACH BRAND OR GRADE OF PESTICIDE REGISTERED. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 143-468 reads as rewritten: "§ 143-468. Disposition of fees. fees and charges. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), all All-fees and charges received by the Board under this Article shall be deposited in credited to the Department of Agriculture General Fund Budget for the purpose of administration and enforcement of this Article, with proper approved accounting procedures accounting for all expenditures and receipts.

Sec. 2. G.S. 143-442(b) is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

- "(b) The applicant shall pay an annual registration fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) plus an additional annual assessment of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each brand or grade of pesticide registered. An additional two hundred dollars (\$200.00) delinquent registration penalty shall be assessed against the registrant for each brand or grade of pesticide which is marketed in North Carolina prior to registration as required by this Article. In the case of multi-year registration, the annual fee and additional assessment for each year shall be paid at the time of the initial registration, provided that registration. The Board shall give a pro rata refund of the registration fee shall be made and additional assessment to the registrant in the event that registration is canceled by the North Carolina Pesticide-Board or by the United States Environmental Protection Agency."
- Sec. 3. This act becomes effective January 1, 1994, and applies to all applications for registration filed under G.S. 143-442 on or after that date.
