AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO CAPE CARTERET IN CARTERET COUNTY TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF WASTEWATER TREATMENT AND DISPOSAL ISSUES IN CARTERET COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Cape Carteret the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to conduct a feasibility study of wastewater treatment and disposal issues in Carteret County, provided these funds are matched on the basis of one dollar (\$1.00) of non-State funds for every two dollars (\$2.00) of State funds. The study shall be conducted by the following nine incorporated towns and cities in Carteret County that have entered into a local joint agency agreement to do the feasibility study: Atlantic Beach, Beaufort, Cape Carteret, Cedar Point, Emerald Isle, Indian Beach, Morehead City, Newport, and Pine Knoll Shores.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
