A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO ALLOW MACON COUNTY TO ACQUIRE PROPERTY FOR USE BY
2 THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION AND TO AUTHORIZE THE MACON
3 COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION TO CONVEY PROPERTY TO THE
4 COUNTY IN CONNECTION WITH IMPROVEMENTS AND REPAIR OF THE
5 PROPERTY.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 885 of the 1989 Session Laws, as amended
9 by Chapters 120, 533, 832, 848, 865, and 1001 of the 1991 Session Laws, reads as
10 rewritten:

11 "Sec. 2. This act applies only to Macon, Bladen, Cabarrus, Carteret, Columbus,
12 Duplin, Franklin, Iredell, Pender, Richmond, Rowan, Sampson, and Stanly Counties."

13 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 115C-518 and G.S. 160A-
14 274, a local board of education may lease or sell any of its property to the board of
15 commissioners of the county in which the property is located for any price negotiated
16 between the two boards.

17 Sec. 3. Section 2 of this act applies only to Macon County and to local
18 boards of education for school administrative units in or for Macon County. Section 2
19 of this act applies only to sales and leases of property in connection with additions,
20 improvements, renovations, or repairs to the property or to some part of the property.

21 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
