A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE RUNNING OF DEER WITH DOGS IN DURHAM 3 COUNTY.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. It is unlawful to run or take deer with the aid of dogs, unless the 6 hunter has in his possession written permission of the owner of the land to run or take 7 deer with dogs, and provided that the land is located within the geographic area 8 designated by the Wildlife Resources Commission as an area in which running or taking 9 deer with dogs is permitted.

10 Sec. 2. Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor.

11 Sec. 3. This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife 12 Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by peace officers with 13 general subject matter jurisdiction.

- Sec. 4. This act applies only to Durham County.
- 15 Sec. 5. This act becomes effective October 1, 1994.
