HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 296

Sponsors: Representatives Morgan; and Devane.

Referred to: Rules, Calendar and Operations of the House.

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING PINEHURST AS THE GOLF CAPITAL
2 OF THE WORLD.

3 Whereas, the Village of Pinehurst has a high quality of life and has achieved
4 economic success; and

5 Whereas, Pinehurst's national and international reputation attracts national
6 and international travellers to North Carolina; and

7 Whereas, the sport of golf is a vital contributor to the economy of Pinehurst,
8 Moore County, and the State of North Carolina; and

9 Whereas, the Pinehurst Resort and Country Club is the largest golf resort in
10 the world; and

11 Whereas, the Pinehurst Resort and Country Club has played a significant role
12 in the development of golf in America; and

13 Whereas, the Pinehurst Resort and Country Club is the site of numerous
14 amateur and professional golf tournaments; and

15 Whereas, the North and South Men's Amateur Tournament, the longest
16 continuous amateur golf event in the United States, has been held at the Pinehurst
17 Resort and Country Club since 1901; and

18 Whereas, the Pinehurst Resort and Country Club is approaching its
19 Centennial; and

20 Whereas, the Pinehurst Resort and Country Club's No. 2 golf course is
21 recognized as one of the top 10 golf courses in the world; and

22 Whereas, Donald Ross, the father of American golf course architecture and
23 the designer of Pinehurst No. 2 and many of the area golf courses, lived in the Village
24 of Pinehurst;

- 1 Now, therefore, be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:
2 Section 1. The General Assembly wishes to recognize Pinehurst as the Golf
3 Capital of the World.
4 Sec. 2. The Secretary of State shall send a certified copy of this resolution to
5 the Mayor of Pinehurst.
6 Sec. 3. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
