5	Section 1. Effective January 1, 1994, G.S. 110-91(7) reads as rewritten:	
6	"(7) Staff-Child Ratio. – In determining the staff-child	ratio, all children
7	younger than 13 years shall be counted. The Comm	ission shall adopt
8	rules regarding staff-child ratios, group sizes and multi-age groupings	
9	for each category of facility other than for infar	nts and toddlers,
10	provided that such rules and regulations shall be no less stringent than	
11	those currently required for staff-child ratios as enacted in Section	
12	156(e) of Chapter 757 of the 1985 Session Laws. The	e staff-child ratios
13	and group sizes for infants and toddlers are as follows:

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Day Care Section, Division of Facility Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of six hundred thirty-four thousand seven hundred forty dollars (\$634,740) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of six hundred forty thousand one hundred dollars (\$640,100) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to implement this act.

1 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective January 1, 1994.
