2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER MAY CARRY				
3	A CONCEALED WEAPON WHEN OFF-DUTY IN NORTH CAROLINA.				
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:				
5	Section 1. G.S. 14-269(b) reads as rewritten:				
6	"(b)	This p	prohibition shall not apply to the following persons:		
7		(1)	Officers and enlisted personnel of the armed forces of the United		
8			States when in discharge of their official duties as such and acting		
9			under orders requiring them to carry arms and weapons;		
10		(2)	Civil officers of the United States while in the discharge of their		
11			official duties;		
12		(3)	Officers and soldiers of the militia and the national guard when called		
13			into actual service;		
14		(4)	Officers of the State, or of any county, city, or town, charged with the		
15			execution of the laws of the State, when acting in the discharge of their		
16			official duties;		
17		(5)	Full-time sworn law-enforcement North Carolina law enforcement		
18			officers, when off-duty, in the jurisdiction where they are assigned, and		
19			within this State, if:		
20			a. Written regulations authorizing the carrying of concealed		
21			weapons have been filed with the clerk of superior court in the		

1		county where the law-enforcement law enforcement unit is
2		located by the sheriff or chief of police or other superior officer
3		in <del>charge; and <u>charge;</u></del>
4	b.	Such regulations specifically prohibit the carrying of concealed
5		weapons while the officer is consuming or under the influence
6		of alcoholic <del>beverages. <u>beverages;</u> and</del>
7	<u>c.</u>	The full-time sworn law enforcement officer is not in violation
8		of such written regulations."
9	Sec. 2. This	act is effective upon ratification.
