A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO ALLOW FOR CERTAIN CRIMINAL RECORD CHECKS OF
2 EMPLOYEES, APPLICANTS FOR EMPLOYMENT, AND VOLUNTEERS IN
3 THE SCHOOLS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 114-19.2 is amended by inserting a new subsection to read:

7 "(c1) The Department of Justice may provide a criminal record check to the schools
8 within the Department of Human Resources of a person who is employed, applies for
9 employment, or applies to be selected as a volunteer, if the employee or applicant
10 consents to the record check. The Department of Human Resources shall keep all
11 information pursuant to this subsection confidential, as provided in Article 7 of Chapter
12 126 of the General Statutes."

13 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1993, and applies to record
14 checks on or after that date.
