March 25, 1993 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO MAKE THE UNAUTHORIZED DUPLICATION OF A KEY TO A STATE BUILDING A MISDEMEANOR OFFENSE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Article 52 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 14-401.15. Unauthorized duplication of a State building key. Any person who duplicates a key to a State-owned building without authority to do so from the Secretary of Administration is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment of up to six months, a fine of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), or both. The Secretary of Administration shall designate those individuals who may duplicate a key to a State-owned building." Sec. 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1993, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
