A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AMEND THE POWERS OF THE NEW HANOVER COUNTY
2 AIRPORT AUTHORITY, AND RELATING TO THE DARE COUNTY AIRPORT
3 AUTHORITY.
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5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Section 4 of Chapter 404 of the 1989 Session Laws, as amended
7 by Chapter 748 of the 1989 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

8 "Sec. 4. Said Airport Authority shall constitute a body, both corporate and politic,
9 and may:

- 10 (1) Purchase, acquire, establish, construct, own, control, lease, equip,
11 improve, maintain, operate, and regulate the New Hanover County
12 International Airport for the use of airplanes, and other aircraft, and all
13 facilities incidental to the operation of such airport, within the limits of
14 New Hanover County; and for any of such purposes, to purchase,
15 acquire, own, hold, lease and/or operate real or personal property;
- 16 (2) Purchase real or personal property;
- 17 (3) Sue or be sued in the name of the Airport Authority, make contracts
18 necessary for the exercise of the powers of the Airport Authority, and
19 acquire by purchase, lease, or otherwise, any existing lease, leasehold
20 right or other interest in any existing airport located in New Hanover
21 County;
- 22 (4) Charge and collect reasonable and adequate fees, royalties, rents or
23 other charges for the use of the property owned, leased or otherwise

- 1 controlled or operated by said Airport Authority or for services
2 rendered in the operation thereof;
- 3 (5) Make all reasonable rules and regulations as it deems necessary for the
4 proper maintenance, use, operation, and control of any airport or
5 airport facilities owned, leased, or otherwise controlled by said Airport
6 Authority; to provide penalties for the violation of such rules and
7 regulations; provided said rules and regulations and penalties be not in
8 conflict with the laws of the State of North Carolina and the rules and
9 regulations of the Federal Aviation Administration;
- 10 (6) Sell, lease, or otherwise dispose of, any property, real or personal,
11 belonging to the Airport Authority, but no sale of real property shall be
12 made without the approval of the Board of County Commissioners of
13 New Hanover County and the Federal Aviation Administration;
- 14 (7) Purchase such insurance as said Airport Authority shall deem
15 necessary;
- 16 (8) Deposit or invest and reinvest any of its funds as provided by the Local
17 Government Finance Act, as it may be amended from time to time, for
18 the deposit or investment of unit funds;
- 19 (9) Operate, own, lease, control, regulate, or grant to others the right to
20 operate on any airport premises, restaurants, snack bars, and vending
21 machines, food and beverage dispensing outlets, rental car services,
22 catering services, novelty shops, insurance sales, advertising media,
23 merchandising outlets, motels, hotels, barber shops, automobile
24 parking and storage facilities, automobile service stations, garage
25 service facilities, motion pictures, personal service establishments and
26 all other types of facilities as may be directly or indirectly related to
27 the maintenance and furnishing to the general public of a complete air
28 terminal installation;
- 29 (10) Possess the same exemptions in respect to payment of taxes and
30 license fees and be eligible for sales and use tax refunds to the same
31 extent as provided for municipal corporations by the laws of the State
32 of North Carolina;
- 33 (11) Issue revenue bonds pursuant to Article 5 of Chapter 159 of the
34 General Statutes of North Carolina;
- 35 (12) Have all the same power and authority granted to cities and counties
36 pursuant to General Statutes Chapter 63, AERONAUTICS;
- 37 (13) Have a corporate seal which may be altered at ~~will~~-will; and
- 38 (14) Engage, on an airport, in commercial, industrial and manufacturing
39 projects which relate to, develop, or further airborne commerce and
40 cargo and passenger traffic, and, in connection with any project,
41 improve real estate on an airport and lease that improved real estate to
42 public or private commercial and industrial enterprises, or contract
43 with others to do so."

1 Sec. 2. Section 2 of Chapter 503 of the 1971 Session Laws, as amended by
2 Chapter 161 of the 1977 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

3 "Sec. 2. The Airport Authority shall consist of nine members who shall be
4 appointed to staggered terms of four years by the Dare County Board of
5 Commissioners. Any member may be removed without cause by the affirmative vote of
6 five members of the Board of Commissioners after written notice to the member that the
7 member's removal will be considered by the Board of Commissioners. The written
8 notice shall be provided to the member at least 15 days before the Board of
9 Commissioners may remove the member. All of the members shall be residents of the
10 County of Dare. Each of the members and their successors so appointed shall take and
11 subscribe to an oath of office before the Clerk of the Superior Court of Dare County and
12 file same with the County Commissioners of Dare County. Upon the occurrence of any
13 vacancy on said Authority, said vacancy shall be filled within sixty (60) days after
14 notice thereof at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners."

15 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
