Article 4A of Chapter 90 of the General Statutes is amended by 7 8 adding a new section to read: "§ 90-85.21.1. Applicability to out-of-state operations. Any pharmacy operating outside the State which ships, mails, or delivers in any 10 manner a dispensed legend drug into this State shall hold a pharmacy license issued by 11 the Board, and that part of the pharmacy operation dispensing the prescription for a 12 North Carolina resident shall abide by North Carolina law and the Board's rules and 13 regulations." 14 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1993. 15
