Section 1. Article 52 of Chapter 14 is amended by adding a new section to read:

## "§ 14-401.15. Failure to pay penalty for late return of video.

- (a) For the purpose of this section, the term 'video rental store' means any entity whose principal business is the rental of video cassette tapes for noncommercial use.
- (b) Any person who (i) rents a video cassette tape from a video rental store, (ii) fails to return it by the date it is due, and (iii) fails to pay the late payment fee assessed for the late return of the video cassette tape within 10 days after receiving notice of the late payment fee from the video rental store is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00).
- (c) Any video rental store that charges a late payment fee for the late return of a video cassette tape shall post at each counter the following warning in block letters not less than one inch in height:

'IT IS UNLAWFUL TO FAIL TO PAY THE PENALTY ASSESSED FOR THE LATE RETURN OF ANY RENTED VIDEO CASSETTE TAPE."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1993, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
