AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE PROCESS LEADERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAM AT FAYETTEVILLE STATE UNIVERSITY.

Whereas, various organizations from communities throughout the State are being trained at Fayetteville State University in local strategic planning; and

Whereas, Fayetteville State University is involved in the support of local strategic planning in the Cumberland County area through the MetroVisions Program; and

Whereas, local strategic planning includes the innovative concept of process leadership that has been developed by many local leaders throughout the State of North Carolina and is being taught at Fayetteville State University; and

Whereas, local community-based strategic planning can provide effective leaders trained to build consensus on important issues of community concern; and

Whereas, funds are needed to provide effective follow-through to assure that comprehensive results are facilitated by local strategic planning; Now, therefore, The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year to fund the Process Leadership Training Program at Fayetteville State University, a program established to train process leaders in North Carolina in local strategic planning.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
